Located just 15 minutes west of downtown amid the beautiful boulevards of Chicago's West Side, the Garfield Park Conservatory is a unique architecturally significant cultural center and historic landmark. The Garfield Park Conservatory was designed by celebrated landscape architect Jens Jensen and opened to the public in 1908. The Conservatory offers respite to millions of Chicagoans and to visitors from around the world who visit the Conservatory to enjoy the plant collection, art exhibitions, to revive and rejuvenate themselves during the harsh Chicago winters and to enjoy the peaceful and tranquil display houses set over 12 acres of green.

One of the largest historic public conservatories in the world, Garfield Park Conservatory displays exotic species of palms, ferns, cacti and tropical plants in landscaped settings under glass, as well as a variety of flora showcased in multiple beautiful outdoor gardens. The Conservatory, which is owned and operated by the Chicago Park District, is open 365 days of the year, with free admission and parking.

The Garfield Park Conservatory Alliance was incorporated as a nonprofit 501c3 organization in 1998 to support the Conservatory with dynamic programming, special events and resources, visitor services and fundraising. Recipient of the National Medal for Museum and Library Science in 2013, the Alliance interprets the Conservatory's extraordinary plant collection for all Chicagoans.

The Garfield Park Conservatory Alliance brings together people, plants and culture in an urban oasis like no other in the world. The Conservatory serves more than 230,000 visitors a year, including 18,000 local school children with inspiring and engaging resources about plants, nature and gardening through a variety of programs including school tours, educational family activities, gardening and beekeeping classes.
